The Lady Byron School is an independent, SEND specialist school located in Leicestershire, funded by the local authority. The school is dedicated to supporting young people who face challenges accessing mainstream education due to various factors. All students enrolled at The Lady Byron School have been diagnosed with autism and hold an Educational, Health, and Care Plan (EHCP).

What is a 'Private Candidate'?



A private candidate is someone who enters for exams through an AQA-approved school or college but is not enrolled as a student there. You may be self-taught, home-schooled or have private tuition with a tutor or through a distance learning provider.

You can only become a private candidate with us in the UK. Exams are not available for private candidates to sit outside the UK.

Who and how we support



We provide a supportive environment for young people with an EHCP to sit their exams in a small, calm and distraction free setting. We offer:

Experienced Staff: Our team ensures students feel supported throughout the process.

Access Arrangements: We can assist in arranging necessary accommodations to reduce anxiety and help students perform their best. (must be finalised in advance.)
